1. Tick the attitude that you think being correct.

- A. When the traffic light is red, I cross the street at once because I have priority.
- B. When the pedestrian light is green, I cross looking carefully to the left and to the right to check that there are no cars.

ANSWERS

- 1. Answer B.** When the pedestrian light is green, you are allowed to cross. However, don't forget to look to the right and to the left, because some cars may not slow down. You have to pay attention to the pedestrian light and not to the traffic light, because some cars go by when the light is orange.
- 2. Answer C.** Road signs are effectively sorted by "family". Situated at the edge of the roads, they are intended for all the users: car, motor bike, truck, bicycle, etc, and also for the pedestrians.
- 3. Answer A.** If you choose to go for a ride with your friends, take care that everyone has its bicycle. It's out of the question to carry someone on the handlebars or the carrier. You must ride on the right of the road (or on the cycle track if there's one) and be one behind the other, in single file. So, you won't disturb the other road users. You will also have to keep you safety distances between each other to be able to brake (with your brakes, not with your feet) without putting the others in danger.
- 4. Answer C.** Before going for a ride with a bike, you have to check that the bike is working (inflated tires, lights which light up) and wear the right equipment (helmet and reflecting waistcoat).
- 5. Answer C.** If someone has to stop abruptly, he should indicate it to the other users by using his hazard warning lights (in a traffic jam for example). On the other hand, if someone runs out of petrol, it is necessary to add to the hazard warning lights the safety triangle in order to warn the motorists of the danger as well as possible. The indicator is used to indicate that someone will overtake or turn.
- 6. Answer B.** The sign described means "Risk of falling rocks". Therefore it indicates to the road users that at this place, there is a risk of rockfalls.
- 7. Answer A.** The bus is a collective means of transport and there are rules to be respected on board. You have to wait at the bus stop in a calm way. During the trip, you have to seat if there are available seats or stay upright holding the bar. Your bag must be at your feet (or on your lap) in order not to disturb anybody.
- 8. Answers A, B and E.** When you use a public transport like the bus, the subway or the tramway, it's necessary to adopt a responsible attitude. The boarding is done in a calm way. Then, it's necessary to sit down quietly or to hold a bar. The bags are on the lap or deposited at your feet but not in the aisle where they would disturb the way. Don't make noise in order to respect the driver and the passengers, and don't make stupid things. While going down, it is necessary to take care not to hustle anybody.
- 9. Answer B.** When there is some fog, the visibility is much reduced. So you should carry a visible outfit and a reflective waistcoat in order to be seen and move in full safety. To make slides is very tempting but you should never endanger yourself because the cars can skid on the icy or snow-covered roadway.
- 10. Answer C.** During a storm, visibility is reduced. Lea must switch on her headlights and wear her reflecting waistcoat. Even if she's scared, she has to come back home quietly, staying very careful because the road can be slippery!
