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OUR PROJECT: inspiration

We have been working in a project for nearly four months, outlining the details and putting thought on our main goal: prevent people from having accidents in the streets and awaring the population about their ways of driving.

We found our motivation to start with this project by seeing the students of our high school crossing the street without caring of cars or motorcycles. We were concerned about the fact that there were practically no traffic signals to aware the drivers that they are in a scholar area and about the kids being unconscious of the road hazards.
