

Dear Mrs. Mayoress Mireia Ingla,

We are a group of high school from Àgora Sant Cugat International School. We are Beth Vila, Rodrigo Sarasquete, Olivia Hageman, Julia Church and Clara Blosca, and we are participating in the YOUR Ideas YOUR Initiatives 2019 - 2020 contest, which is a contest on road safety and sustainable mobility promoted by the Renault company, worldwide, with an educational purpose.

Our project has the objective of making young people aware of the effects that alcohol has on driving with the purpose of preventing traffic accidents and reducing the mortality of drivers due to alcohol consumption when they go out to party.

Let us be clear that the best way for us to prevent accidents would be zero consumption of alcohol, but seeing that there are many advertisements that promote this, and the numbers haven't change, we have thought on alternative solutions. In addition, as adolescents, we have been able to see these behaviors in people of our age and older, getting into vehicles after drinking and without thinking that their lives and those of their friends may be in danger. To demonstrate the seriousness of the situation, we provide the following information: according to the ABC newspaper in Catalonia, 50% of fatal accidents on the roads have tested positive for alcohol and drugs in 2019.

We would like to explain the different parts that make up our project: After documenting ourselves about the influence of alcohol on traffic accidents, we have carried out a research, we created and shared a survey to find out how much young people know about driving rules related to alcohol. We obtained nearly 400 responses in less than 24 hours, which we analyzed to assess the awareness that young people have on the subject. We have also recorded a short film that captures the message we want to convey, with the intention of uploading it to social networks and expanding awareness among young people. They can see at the following link: <https://youtu.be/hnsw4eXXDP4> . And finally we ask for your help to ensure that, at least in our town, if alcohol consumption is not zero, mortality is.

**Our proposal** is that the City Council charter two buses that take a route from the area where the discotheques are located in Sant Cugat to the different neighborhoods that make up the municipality and nearby cities. This would be an effective way to ensure the safety of young people and avoid any possible accidents. Also keep in mind that the train service is very limited at those early hours. We believe that the right place to provide these vehicles is the roundabout where the Carretera de Can Solà, the Avenida de les Roquetes and the Avenida de

les Corts Catalanes meet. It is the area where three large discotheques are located: Bocca Restaurant & Club, Teatre Sant Cugat, Moon Club and Star Light.

The idea is to provide two buses on Friday and Saturday nights to make the route, one at 3:30 and the other at 5:00. This would be the summary of your tour:

**BUS 1:** From the discotheques to the Bellaterra train station (9 min), from Bellaterra to the town hall of Cerdanyola (11min), and from Cerdanyola back to the clubs (8 min).

**BUS 2:** From the discos to the Sant Cugat train station (8 min), from there to the Valldoreix train station (8 min), from Valldoreix to the Mira-so station (6 min), and from there return to the discotheques (8 min).

Departure: Av de les Roquetes

Stop 1: Ctra. De Vallvidrera-Turó de Can Mates

Stop 2: Plaça Can Cadena

Stop 3: Estació de la Floresta

Stop 4: Estació de Mirasol

Stop 5: Av. De Montserrat Roig- Hospital General de Catalunya

We would appreciate that you consider our proposal for and that this project goes ahead and reaches its purpose: to avoid traffic accidents among the youngest after partying and consuming alcohol.


